Vocabulary using the Six Types of Syllables

Words	Closed Syllable (ends in at least one consonant and the vowel is short)	Open Syllable (ends in one vowel and the vowel is long).	Vowel Consonant-e Syllable (ends in one long vowel, one consonant, and silent e)	Vowel –r Syllable (has an r after the vowel and the vowel makes an unexpected sound)	Vowel Pair Syllable (has two adjacent vowels and treat each vowel pair with care)	Final Stable Syllable (a final consonant combination and an accent the syllable before) -tion, -le, -sion, -ture
Examples	men, hip, not,	me, hi, no	name, theme, five rope, cube	star, her, sir, world, fur	book, meat, boat, toes, sail, pie, cues, meet	candle, retention conclusion, adventure,
